DBS' Child Abuse Protocol

When students attend DBS, whether in traditional classroom settings or in virtual classroom settings, teachers and professionals across the school, are responsible for ensuring that students are safe from any form of abuse.

To ensure that students are safe from harm, teachers are trained to identify signs of abuse, including what to do if they are worried about the safety of students.

If you observe any actual or suspected instances of Abuse:

- If teacher and/or any professional DBS staff observe or suspect any form of child abuse
- Write report about observation & submit to Head of Department
- Head of Department will forward to Principal & Wellbeing Center Team
- An investigation & report will ensue
- Report submitted to Mrs. Samar, Superintendent of Schools, who will address the matter with appropriate authorities
- Student will continue engaging in a continuous flow of services offered via wellbeing center
